- Eligibility requirements are limited to the results of the language test taken within the last two years as of the application deadline for our graduate school.
- Temporary application of admission for 2021 Fall Semester due to the special circumstances of the spread of COVID-19 around the world:
 - Temporarily accept the IELTS Indicator due to the suspension of the IELTS test
 - Language proficiency test taken after the application deadline can also be accepted. Proof of language proficiency must be submitted by visit, post or e-mail by June 30, 2021 (Wed) 18:00(Korean time) [In case of submitting by e-mail, original documents must be submitted by in-person or post no later than August 27, 2021 (Fri)]
- In case of submitting TOPIK level 3 score, please be noted that student should take TOPIK test again and submit TOPIK level 4 or higher by the time of graduation. This is KIT graduation rule.
- If candidates are from the country where English is spoken as first language(USA, Canada, UK, Ireland, Australia, New Zealand, South Africa), the English Proficiency Test might not be required to hand in.
- In case of GKS(Global Korea Scholarship) students invited by the Korean Government, those who have achieved 70% (84 points) or more of the minimum score of TOPIK level 3 can be admitted according to the Academic Guidelines of NIIED(National Institute for International Education).

3 Scholarship

3-1 Scholarship for Freshmen & Enrolled Students

- KIT provides scholarships for international students. The detailed criteria, language proficiency score and scholarship duration will be decided later according to the yearly budget. Maximum 4 semesters of scholarships each for Master's degree candidates and Doctoral degree candidates and maximum 8 semesters of scholarships for Integrated Master's and Doctoral degree candidates can be provided to international students only if budget allows for it.

- Minimum language test score for Type A and B scholarship is as below.

- ※ All students who meet the Type B scholarship selection criteria will receive the Scholarship(50% of tuition).
However, Type A Scholarship can be selected and paid after the deliberation by Graduate School Committee within the scope of the scholarship budget.

3-3 Precondition for scholarship benefit (Insurance condition)

- Restrictions on scholarship benefits depending on insurance
 - Scholarship will be cancelled if scholar does not purchase medical insurance
 - Freshmen must submit the certificate of medical insurance within 30 days from the beginning of the semester.

Application Fee & Process

- Application Fee: Free
- Admission Process:
 - 1) To fill up online application through KIT webpage (www.kumoh.ac.kr, [Click here \(2021 Fall\)](#)) and to submit original application documents by post mail (Both ways have to be completed)
 - 2) Paper screening/interview(if necessary) by each department/faculty
 - 3) Successful applicants to be decided by Graduate school admission committee

Accommodation

- International students can stay at on-campus dormitory.
- Room & board fee should be paid by student's own expense.

Additional Information

- Every required document must be **written in Korean or English** and the **original copy of document must arrive before the deadline**. (Notarized Korean or English translation required in case of other languages)
- We accept original documents only(except diploma). Photocopies of documents must be verified by the originals. In case of submitting photocopied documents, applicants must have the copies notarized or apostilled and then submit the notarized or apostilled copies.
- Photo must be taken within the past 3 months and show only the upper body without cap.
- In case of an applicant who has not yet graduated but will apply at KIT before finish their studies, applicant should **submit the certificate of graduation** before the 1st day of semester.
- **If the information in the submitted documents is found to be fake, or if the applicant is accepted by falsification of documents or other illegal methods, the admission will be canceled, and even after enrollment.**
- Submitted documents will not be returned to the applicants.
- Additional documents other than the submitted documents may be requested for accurate qualification screening.

Other Guidelines

- Admission will be cancelled in case tuition is not paid during the designated period.
- Applicant must write down exact mailing address and telephone number.
 - **Communication cut off is applicant's own responsibility.**
 - **Applicant must directly leave new contact number in case of any change.**
- Announcement of acceptance will be released on the KIT webpage (www.kumoh.ac.kr, <http://eng.kumoh.ac.kr>) and applicant will not be informed individually.
- Any unexpected notices will be informed on KIT webpage and applicant will not be informed individually.
- Chinese student must submit the diploma from "China Academic Degree Graduate Education Development Center" (www.cdgd.edu.cn) or Verification of Academic Qualification by the Division of Education at the Chinese Embassy in Korea (www.eoe.or.kr). Chinese student who graduated from Korean university does not have to do this.
- Items not mentioned above will be decided by the committee of KIT's Graduate School.
